More detail on the definitions of Rarity Status in the 'Hampshire Rare Plant Register' by Rand & Mundell, published in 2010.

Note that here 'County' means Vice County 12 (VC12), North Hampshire.

In simplified terms:

Nationally Rare means recorded in 1-15 10km squares (hectads) In Britain since 1987.

Nationally Scarce means recorded in 16-100 10km squares in Britain since 1987.

County Rare means recorded in 1-3 sites in VC12, North Hampshire, since 1987.

County Scarce means recorded in 4-10 sites in VC12, North Hampshire, since 1987.
