FROYLE RECREATION GROUND

We plan to construct a Living Willow Dome with volunteer help on Saturday **29th February 10am-12 and 1-3pm.**



We are sowing cornfield annuals again on the 5x10m plot.

Volunteer assistance appreciated on the following Saturdays

21st March 2-4pm Weed, rotovate & edge the plot

4th April 2-4pm Rake, level, sow seed

The annual cut of the perennial wildflower meadow area on the recreation ground is planned for the end of July.

25th July 2-4pm Rake up and remove cuttings
(cut a few days previously by scythe)

THE WILDLIFE POND AREA

This area near Gid Lane has been grazed by sheep in winter as part of the maintenance plan. The meadow area sown in 2016 has established well but will still benefit from light weeding. Also paths need mowing through the meadow area for visitor access.

Join us if you can help on the following Saturdays

28th March 10am-12 Move sheep fencing - pick up stones

20th April 10am-12 (Monday) Remove electric sheep fence

25th April 10am-12 Mow paths - pull nettles & thistles

16th May 10am-12 Mow paths - remove weeds

30th May 10am-12 Mow paths - cut nettles

Mow paths as needed around 4th July and 8th August.

5th Sept 10am-12 Scythe selected areas of meadow

Sept To be arranged Thin reedmace, rake and remove cuttings

5th Oct 10am-12 (Monday) Erect sheep fencing
